

MTASM RECITAL REQUIREMENTS DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

To help ensure the safety of our students, their family members and our teachers, the following requirements will be in place for MTASM recitals and activities until further notice:

- 1) To allow for social distancing, each recital will be limited to 10 families.
- 2) A copy of the program for each recital will be emailed to each participating teacher. Teachers will be asked to forward the email to each participating family. Families are asked to bring the program (paper or online copy) to the recital.
- 3) Families will remain in their cars when they arrive until the chairperson opens the entry door. Families will go directly to designated seats upon entering rather than checking in or visiting in the lobby area.
- 4) All families and teachers need to wear masks until they are seated. Masks may be removed at that time until leaving the recital.
- 5) Students will be asked to use hand sanitizer before and after performing. The piano keys will be cleaned with a sanitizing wipe between each performer.
- 6) There will be no group pictures.
- 7) Families will be asked to put on their masks and directed when to leave at the end of the recital. Please go directly outside rather than visiting in the lobby area. Those who wish to visit or take pictures may do so outside, but are asked to stand away from the entry door so that the next group may enter.
- 8) Families are asked to refrain from using the church bathrooms if at all possible.
- 9) Depending on health concerns and directives in Maryland and our county, recitals will be cancelled if necessary.
- 10) Each participating family and teacher will need to, per Music Teachers National Association and the Maryland State Music Teachers Association requirements, need to sign an Association Waiver and Release of Liability for Exposure to Covid-19 form at the time of registration for the recital.
